



**A SURVEY OF ADULTS  
IN  
NEW YORK CITY AND LONG ISLAND**

**February 26 - March 1, 2017**

## METHODS

The following topline and crosstabs contain data from a poll of 600 adults in New York City and Long Island. The poll was conducted from February 26 - March 1, 2017 via landline and cell phone. Findings applying to the 600 sample are subject to sampling error of plus or minus 3.9%. Subgroups of the sample are subject to error of up to plus or minus 10%.

The following definitions describe subgroups used in the crosstabs. Percentages in parentheses refer to each subgroup's proportion of the total sample. Question numbers from which the subgroups are derived are also included.

### CROSSTAB KEY

- **REGION** *New York City* (75%) includes respondents who live in one of the five boroughs of New York City – the Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Queens, or Staten Island. *Long Island* (25%) includes respondents who live in Nassau County or Suffolk County (Q.2).
- **TAKEN ANTIBIOTIC AS ADULT** *Yes* (88%) includes respondents who have been prescribed an antibiotic as an adult. *No* (12%) includes respondents who have not been prescribed an antibiotic as an adult (Q.3).
- **RACE** *White* (47%) includes respondents who are white or multi-racial including white. *Black* (16%) includes respondents who are black/African American or multi-racial including black/African American. *Hispanic* (29%) includes respondents who are of Latino, Hispanic, or Spanish origin, or who volunteer Latino, Hispanic, or Spanish as their race, or are multi-racial, including Latino, Hispanic, or Spanish. *Other* (20%) includes respondents who are American Indian, Asian, or of some other race or are multi-racial including American Indian, Asian, or another race (Q.12, Q.13).
- **GENDER** *Men* (47%) includes male respondents. *Women* (53%) includes female respondents (Q.14).
- **AGE** *18-34* (30%) includes respondents age 18-34. *35-49* (31%) includes respondents age 35-49. *50-64* (22%) includes respondents age 50-64. *65+* (15%) includes respondents age 65 and over (Q.11).
- **GENDER/AGE** *Men under 50* (27%) includes male respondents age 18-49. *Men 50+* (19%) includes male respondents age 50 and over. *Women under 50* (34%) includes female respondents age 18-49. *Women 50+* (17%) includes female respondents age 50 or over (Q.11, Q.14).
