



**A SURVEY OF PARENTS
IN
NEW YORK CITY AND LONG ISLAND**

June 19-22, 2017

METHODS

The following topline and crosstabs contain data from a poll of 600 parents in New York City and Long Island. The poll was conducted from June 19-22, 2017 via landline and cell phone. Findings applying to the 600 sample are subject to sampling error of plus or minus 3.9%. Subgroups of the sample are subject to error of up to plus or minus 10%.

The following definitions describe subgroups used in the crosstabs. Percentages in parentheses refer to each subgroup's proportion of the total sample. Question numbers from which the subgroups are derived are also included.

CROSSTAB KEY

- **REGION** *New York City* (75%) includes parents who live in one of the five boroughs of New York City – the Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Queens, or Staten Island. *Long Island* (25%) includes parents who live in Nassau County or Suffolk County (Q.2).
- **CHILDREN** *Under 18* (53%) includes parents who only have children under age 18. *Grown* (35%) includes parents whose children are all age 18 and over. *Both* (12%) includes parents who have some children under age 18 and others who are 18 or older (Q.4).
- **VACCINES CAN CAUSE AUTISM** *No* (61%) includes parents who do not believe vaccines can cause autism. *Yes/NS* (39%) includes parents who believe vaccines do cause autism or are not sure if they do or not (Q.9).
- **RACE** *White* (44%) includes parents who are white or multi-racial including white. *Black* (15%) includes parents who are black/African American or multi-racial including black/African American. *Hispanic* (28%) includes parents who are of Latino, Hispanic, or Spanish origin, or who volunteer Latino, Hispanic, or Spanish as their race, or are multi-racial, including Latino, Hispanic, or Spanish. *Other* (13%) includes parents who are American Indian, Asian, or of some other race or are multi-racial including American Indian, Asian, or another race (Q.14, Q.15).
- **GENDER** *Men* (47%) includes fathers. *Women* (53%) includes mothers (Q.16).
- **AGE** *18-34* (23%) includes parents age 18-34. *35-49* (37%) includes parents age 35-49. *50-64* (24%) includes parents age 50-64. *65+* (14%) includes parents age 65 and over (Q.13).

- **GENDER/AGE** *Men under 50* (28%) includes fathers age 18-49. *Men 50+* (17%) includes fathers age 50 and over. *Women under 50* (31%) includes mothers age 18-49. *Women 50+* (22%) includes mothers age 50 or over (Q.13, Q.16).
