Dr. Datta, MD, FACS, FRCS, FICS established Mount Sinai South Nassau's Surgical Oncology Program in 2001. He is trained in surgical oncology and head and neck surgery with a special interest in thyroid/ parathyroid, head and neck tumors, skin cancers, and soft tissue cancers. He trained at Grant Medical College and Tata Memorial Cancer Center in India, with advanced training in plastic surgery and surgical oncology in the UK, prior to a research fellowship at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center. He completed a dual fellowship in surgical oncology and head and neck surgery at Roswell Park Cancer Institute in Buffalo, New York and then served on the faculty of Maimonides Medical Center and Coney Island Hospital. Dr. Datta is also fluent in Hindi and Punjabi.

Dr. Seitelman, MD, FACS is a surgical oncologist who focuses on melanoma, non-melanoma skin, soft tissue malignancies, and breast cancer. He is board certified in general surgery and fellowship trained in complex surgical oncology. A native of New York, he has been practicing since 2012 on Long Island treating patients with skin and soft tissue cancers and breast cancer along with plastic surgeons, medical oncologists, and radiation oncologists in a multidisciplinary fashion. He works with dermatologists to treat and perform active surveillance on melanoma and other skin cancer patients. Working with the NCI designated cancer center at Mount Sinai he has created a vibrant program for the surgical management of melanoma offering world class treatment. New patients with melanoma, other skin cancers, or breast cancer are offered very timely appointments so their disease can be treated quickly. Dr. Seitelman also works with top plastic surgeons to offer patients all breast reconstruction options to help them make the best decisions for their cosmetic outcomes, while still focusing on minimally invasive treatments which involve less pain and less downtime.
